


























Cottonmouth By Miya Coleman






Hated for the Gods By Sean Patrick Mulroy






Rock Stars By Matt Mason






Poetry by Chance: An Anthology of Poems Powered by Metaphor Dice Edited By Taylor Mali






Ephemera By Sierra DeMulder








Helium By Rudy Francisco
